

Terms of Reference

1. Purpose of the Consultancy

Support the ICD-11 Revision – Joint Linearization for Mortality and Morbidity Statistics (JLMMS), in editing and preparation of subclassifications (extension codes) of ICD-11, and support for improvements of user guidance of ICD-11.

2. Background

The revision of ICD-11 has been progressing in different phases, since 2007. In this last phase, ICD-11 is prepared in a version for planning of implementation for release in June 2018. Additional work is necessary to finalize work on different components of ICD-11, including some subclassifications.

3. Work to be performed

Output 1: Provide editorial and classification support to the ongoing ICD development process. This includes organization of content and authoring on an online platform, with special attention to the additional subclassifications.
